

ACETYLSALICYLIC ACID (ASPIRIN)

| THERAPEUTIC EFFECTS | An antipyretic, anti-inflammatory analgesic with properties reducing platelet aggregation that may reduce the size of a blood clot within a coronary artery causing an AMI. |
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| INDICATIONS | For the treatment of patients with suspected AMI. |
| CONTRAINDICATIONS | Hypersensitivity to aspirin or nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory analgesics. |
| PRECAUTIONS/SIDE EFFECTS | Hypersensitivity to aspirin or nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory analgesics. |
| ADULT DOSAGE/ROUTE | 160-325 mg chewable tablet orally. |
