

ACTIVATED CHARCOAL (ACTIDOSE/SORBITAL)

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| THERAPEUTIC EFFECTS | A specially prepared charcoal with a surface that will absorb and bind toxins. |
| INDICATIONS | In poisoning where emesis is contraindicated and administration has been recommended by Poison Control and/or the receiving physician. |
| CONTRAINDICATIONS | An airway that cannot be controlled. |
| PRECAUTIONS/SIDE EFFECTS | Administer only after emesis or in cases where emesis is contraindicated |
| ADULT DOSAGE/ROUTE | 50 gm premix solution given orally. |
| PEDIATRIC DOSAGE/ROUTE | 1 gm/kg premix solution given orally. Maximum dose of 50 gm. |
