



Ketorolac (Toradol)

CLASS:	Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug Peripherally acting nonnarcotic analgesic
ACTIONS:	Inhibits prostaglandin synthesis Analgesic Antipyretic
INDICATIONS:	Pain management
CONTRAINDICATIONS:	Hypersensitivity to the drug Patients with allergies to ASA or other NSAIDs Bleeding disorders Renal Failure/Dialysis Active peptic ulcer disease Head trauma History of Cerebral Hemorrhage Patient is pregnant
PRECAUTIONS:	Ketorolac (Toradol) should be avoided by patients with active ulcer disease or poor renal function. Watch for anaphylaxis in asthmatic patients. Consider reducing dose in patients greater than 65 years of age
SIDE EFFECTS:	Anaphylaxis from hypersensitivity Edema Sedation Bleeding Disorders Rash Nausea Headache
ADULT DOSAGE:	Pain Management: Administer <i>15 mg-30 mg IV/IO/IM</i>
PEDIATRIC DOSAGE:	Not Indicated
