MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this memorandum is to announce a change in approved designated STEMI Receiving Centers for Yolo County.

Effective September 1, 2017 Sutter Medical Center Sacramento is a Designated STEMI Receiving Center.

All Specialty (e.g., Trauma, STEMI, and Stroke) transports originating in Yolo County shall be directed to the closest appropriate, Designated Receiving Center. Please see the updated catchment map. The destination for all patients shall be based upon the clinical capabilities of the receiving hospital and the patient's condition. This does not preclude the transport of patients to non-designated facilities during the course of non-emergency, interfacility transfers or scheduled non-emergency transports at the request or direction of the patient's primary care physician.
